Public transport

You can get to Eawag by <u>foot</u> (see map), <u>train, or tram</u> (see timetable)

- take tram 12 at Zürich-Kloten airport ("Zürich Flughafen Bahnhof") in direction of "Zürich, Bahnhof Stettbach" to get directly to Eawag (stop "Dübendorf, Giessen"); takes 20 mins
- or train from Zürich-Kloten airport to Zürich main station ("Zürich Hauptbahnhof"); 12 mins
- from Zürich main station ("Zürich, Hauptbahnhof") take S-train (S3, S9, S12) to "Zürich, Bahnhof Stettbach"; then tram no. 12 in direction of airport ("Zürich, Flughafen") getting off after two stops at "Dübendorf, Giessen" (5 mins.) and short walk to Eawag

Leaving

The meeting ends on Tuesday at 4 pm. You can reach Zürich airport by 5 pm: take tram no. 12 from "Dübendorf, Giessen" at 16.21 / or 16.36; arriving at "Zürich Flughafen" at 16.42 / or 16.57

Buying tickets

At machines (credit card or cash), or at the "SBB" counters in Zürich airport or Zürich main station; ticket includes trains, bus, tram, and some boats; 2nd class is fine (2017 prices)

- airport to "Dübendorf, Giessen" (near Eawag), 1-way ticket: CHF 4.40 (zones 121, 122, i.e. excluding city of Zürich)
- airport to Zürich main station ("Zürich, Hauptbahnhof"), 1-way ticket: CHF 6.80
- airport to Zürich main station, 24 hours ticket: CHF 13.60 (3 zones: 110, 121; if arriving on Sunday it can be used to get to Eawag on Monday morning)
- you need a ticket to get from Eawag (Dübendorf) to Zürich on Monday evening (dinner)
 1-way ticket: CHF 6.80 / or 24 hours: CHF 13.80 (3 zones: 110, 121; can be used on Tuesday afternoon to get to airport)

Tickets prices are calculated for "zones"

- Zürich (zone 110) counts 2 zones, Kloten (airport) and Dübendorf (Eawag) are in zone 121; if you buy ticket for 3 zones you can freely travel in Zürich and zone 121
- Zürich card for 24 hours (CHF 24.-) or 72 hours (CHF 48.-): valid for the above zones (i.e. includes airport and Eawag in Dübendorf) and other zones; it also includes free or reduced admission to the majority of Zürich's museums, discount in various stores and public city tours organized by <u>Zürich Tourism</u>
