Abstract The Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) broke the mould of development policy on water, becoming influential of policy and programming. The presentation describes some student research activities intended to influence the negotiation of the MDGs' successors – the Sustainable Development Goals. The examples illustrate how simple research on relevant questions can provide important insights and have substantive influence; as a set they contribute to emerging insight into the conditions under which science successfully influences policy and to the field of 'boundary science'.
